Violation: The Licensee allowed an unlicensed individual to use items from his practice to treat patients/animals. Willful or repeated violation of any provisions of this chapter or any rules of the board; Fraud, deception, misrepresentation, dishonest or illegal practices in

or connected with the practice of veterinary medicine in any of its branches; Unprofessional or unethical conduct or engaging in practices in connection with the practice of veterinary medicine that are in violation of the standards of professional conduct as defined in this section or prescribed by the rules of the board; Conduct reflecting unfavorably upon the profession of veterinary medicine; Permitting or allowing another to use the licensee's license for the purpose of treating or offering to treat sick, injured or affected animals; Has been guilty of employing or permitting any person who does not hold a license to practice veterinary medicine in this state to perform work that, under this chapter, can lawfully be done only by persons holding such license and permitted by law to practice veterinary medicine in this state. It shall be conclusively presumed that any unlicensed person, if employed by a licensed person, was employed for such purpose if the unlicensed person has attended any school of veterinary medicine or surgery, accredited or otherwise, for a period of over thirty (30) days; Dispensing, prescribing or otherwise distributing any controlled substance or any other drug not in the course of the accepted practice of veterinary medicine; Failing to responsibly supervise persons to whom veterinary functions are delegated or assigned. Engaging in acts of dishonesty which relate to the practice of veterinary medicine.

Action: Voluntary Surrender of License, Respondent understands that a voluntary surrender has the same effect as a revocation.
