What is Hepatitis C?

Hepatitis C is the most common blood-borne infection in the United States. Over several years, it can **stop the liver from working properly, causing liver cancer and death.**



How is Hepatitis C spread?

Hepatitis C is not spread by casual contact. The most common way Hepatitis C is spread is when people share the same needle when injecting drugs.



What if I am at risk?

If you think you may be **at risk for Hepatitis C**, ask your healthcare provider about testing - and if confirmed to have the virus - about treatment options. The sooner an infection is identified and treatment started, the better a person's chances are for recovery.
