

The Puckett Site: A Paleoindian/Early Archaic Site in Stewart County, Tennessee

The Puckett Site (40SW228) is located along the Cumberland River in Stewart County, Tennessee, within the Cross Creeks National Wildlife Refuge. Test excavations at this locale revealed intact Paleoindian and Early Archaic period deposits (ca. 13,000 – 8,000 years BP). Radiocarbon dates were obtained from levels containing Dalton (9790+160 yr B.P.) and Kirk Corner-Notched (8,820+180 yr B.P.) projectile points. This presentation will highlight the findings from the Puckett site and include other Paleoindian and Early Archaic radiocarbon dates from the region.
