**Archaeological Research at Arnold Air Force Base**

AMEC Earth and Environmental, Inc. conducted archaeological testing at four prehistoric sites on Arnold AFB as part of the base's program to determine the National Register of Historic Places eligibility for all sites within its boundary. These four sites were originally recorded as lithic scatters and are located on terraces overlooking the upper reaches of the Woods Reservoir portion of the Elk River. Previous work at similar sites has shown that there was potential for intact archaeological deposits at these sites which is why they were chosen for further investigation. This presentation will address the methods used during site investigation as well as results including determination that one site does have intact deposits and is eligible for the NRHP. Thanks to Dr. Kevin Smith for presenting his research on the Castalian Springs site at the April meeting.


