INTRODUCTION

The Tennessee Solid Waste Management Act of 1991 (SWMA) provided for the creation of a comprehensive, integrated solid waste management program that is protective of public health and enhances environmental quality by ensuring solid waste facility design, location, and operations will not have a negative impact. TDEC acts as a facilitator for waste reduction by collaborating with municipal and county governments and waste handlers and generators to minimize solid waste disposal and maximize the utilization of resources that would otherwise be disposed at solid waste facilities.

Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) §68-211-873 requires annual reports on this Solid Waste Management System (SWMS) to be prepared and submitted to the Governor and General Assembly. The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) and Office of Sustainable Practices (OSP) have collaborated to produce this annual report for fiscal year (FY) 2014-2015.

The report includes:

- amount of publicly recycled materials (plastic, paper, metal, glass)
- summary of state employee recycling program
- problem wastes management statewide
- solid waste and materials management infrastructure statewide
- amount of material disposed in landfills
- remaining life of municipal solid waste landfills
- financial and technical assistance to local governments
- statewide planning




1. Negative percent values for base year reduction indicate an increase per capita in Class I landfill disposal since the Region's base year.
2. Positive percent values for base year reduction indicate a decrease per capita in Class I landfill disposal since the Region's base year.
3. Real time values do not compare base year, but instead a diversion rate (Total MSW Recycled + Diverted + Class III/IV landfills/Amount Generated) for current year.
4. Base year and Real time methodologies consider Class III/IV landfill disposal as diversion credit towards the 25% waste reduction and diversion goal. The goal is measuring materials diverted away from Class I landfill disposal/incineration facilities.


Waste Diversion in Tennessee

The SWMA set a 25% goal for which Municipal Solid Waste Regions (the Region) are to reduce the amount of waste placed into Class I landfills from a base year measurement taken in 1995. The Regions submit Annual Progress Reports (APR) each year from which waste reduction and diversion efforts are measured. Most waste reduction efforts are reported as recycling generated by the public and private sectors. Most waste diversion efforts are reported as Class III/IV disposal and mulching. The data represented in this section is provided by the Region, unless stated otherwise.



The recycling reports submitted by the public and private sectors contribute to the 25% waste reduction and diversion goal for the Region. However the following data represents publicly owned recycling programs that collect paper, metal, glass, plastic and mixed recyclables. Paper, metal, glass and plastic recycling are offered to residents and businesses throughout the state by local government operated or contracted programs.



2014 Publicly Collected Paper Statewide in Tons




2014 Publicly Collected Paper by County in Tons





2014 Publicly Collected Metal Statewide in Tons




2014 Publicly Collected Metal by County in Tons






2014 Publicly Collected Plastic Statewide in Tons




2014 Publicly Collected Plastic by County in Tons








Household Hazardous Waste

The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) mobile collection service operated by TDEC for the counties continues to be a valuable component of an integrated solid waste management program. Improper storage and disposal of HHW is unsafe for the public, sanitation workers, and the environment. The program provides convenient disposal to those 91 counties that lack a permanent collection facility, at no charge to households. Ninety-four counties have participated in the HHW mobile collection service since the program's inception in 1993. TDEC continues to provide up to four events each Saturday during the collection "season." Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. is the state's contractor for the mobile collection service and has the contract until June 30, 2020.

In Fiscal Year 2014-2015, there were 48 HHW/CESQG events and 41 "milk runs" to pick up pre-collected oil based paint and mercury containing lamps. The collection program received a variety of wastes including flammable liquids, corrosives, oxidizers, elemental mercury, batteries, pesticides and paint. The service was utilized by 6,658 households, who safely disposed of 226,331 pounds of household hazardous waste. An average for all of the events was 4,592 pounds of HHW, at an average cost of \$4,882 per event. Chattanooga, Knoxville, Memphis and Nashville manage permanent HHW collection facilities and are included separately in these calculations. These facilities were constructed with grants from the Fund, as provided for in the Act.

Waste Tire Recycling

The SWMA, T.C.A. §68-211-867(d)(1), prohibits counties from placing shredded tires in landfills after July 1, 2002, if the county's net cost of shredding, transporting, and disposing of the waste tires exceeds the cost of available beneficial end uses. In FY 2014-2015, Tennessee counties recycled a total of 56,309.52 tons of tires and reported landfilling zero tons. T.C.A. §68-211-866(b) requires each county to provide directly, by contract or authority at least one site to receive and store tires.

Unwanted Pharmaceutical Program

In 2011, the Office of Sustainable Practices (OSP) launched a program to aid local governments in collecting unwanted pharmaceuticals. This was in response to emerging concerns from the U.S. Geological Survey and the U.S. EPA regarding the growing levels of pharmaceutical and personal care products found in many of the nation's drinking water supplies. Prior to the program, flushing or landfilling unwanted medicines and personal care products were the suggested disposal methods. The OSP provided secure bins and guidance on collection and safe disposal to allow local law enforcement to provide additional disposal options for citizens. Other state and federal agencies partners include: the Drug Enforcement Administration, Safety and Homeland Security, Health, and Mental Health and Substance Abuse Prevention. Bins are currently located in 78 of the 95 counties in Tennessee, including 29 counties that joined the program in FY 2014-2015. A total of 30,446 pounds of pharmaceuticals were collected in FY 2014-2015. 


State Recycling Programs

The State Employee Recycling Program (SERP), administered by the OSP, provides access to recycling to over 20,000 state employees in 114 facilities, including the main campuses in Memphis, Nashville, Chattanooga, and Knoxville. In FY 2014-2015, employees in state offices recycled mixed office paper, cardboard, and plastic and aluminum beverage containers. Nearly 2,956 tons of paper were recycled through the State's document destruction contract with Shred-It in the first six months of FY 2014-2015.



Many departments have recycling programs for agency-specific commodities. The Department of Transportation provides recycling for lead tire weights, highway signs, and automotive fluids. The Department of Correction provides options through composting, grease, and textile recycling programs.

Tennessee State Parks *Go Green With Us* recycling initiative launched in February 2015. Consistent reporting of recyclables is improving and will transition to quarterly instead of monthly.



State employees celebrated America Recycles Day and the Great American Cleanup by recycling various items including batteries, ink jet cartridges, digital media, and unwanted prescription drugs.

SERP is the point of contact for collecting State agency recycling data reported by Jones Lang LaSalle (JLL), state contractor for facilities management. State agencies not included in JLL's contract will be responsible for working with the Central Procurement Office to contract with a vendor for the collection and processing of traditional recyclable commodities at offices and similar locations. SERP is working toward establishing reporting requirements on all contracts related to recycling. This will allow a better understanding of the total recycling efforts conducted by state government, including mercury lamps, grease, and automotive fluids.


The Department of Tourist Development received the Tennessee Green Hospitality certification for all Welcome Centers across Tennessee. It made a commitment to offer recycling at all locations and expand collection to include paper and cardboard. SERP will continue to assist in these efforts, providing technical support and additional resources.

Disposal in Tennessee

In 2014, Tennesseans generated 11,666,791 tons of municipal solid waste with 6,142,247 tons disposed of in Class I (sanitary) landfills. Class I landfill disposal rate equaled .94 tons per person per year. Using the 1995 base year, the per capita waste reduction and diversion rate for 2014 is 30%.


In 2014, there were 33 permitted Class I landfills in Tennessee with 19 being publicly owned. For permitted Class III and IV (construction and demolition) landfills the state has 63. Approximately 1,225,274 tons of materials were disposed into Class III and IV landfills in 2014. A total of 502 Convenience Centers are permitted throughout the state.





2014 Active Class I Landfills in Tennessee

FINANCIAL AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Recycling Equipment Grant

The recycling equipment grants program assists local governments and non-profit organizations to purchase key pieces of recycling equipment. Items traditionally purchased with this grant include: roll off containers, skid loaders, shredders, scales, balers, glass crushers, and assorted styles of collection containers. This grant is competitive with a maximum award of \$25,000. A matching share of 10%-50% is required and is determined using an economic index. In Fiscal Year 2014-2015: 21 counties, 5 cities, and 2 non-profit recyclers received recycling equipment grants totaling \$531,820.

Recycling Rebates

Each year the top eleven county generators of municipal solid waste are offered recycling rebates which may be used for recycling purposes including establishing, maintaining or expanding recycling operations and systems or providing education for local recycling programs. Municipalities are offered a portion of the rebate. The municipalities may allow their portion to be deferred to the county. There is a one to one matching of funds for this rebate.

Permanent HHW Collection Facility Grant

TDEC contracted with Special Waste Associates (SWA) in FY 2014 to provide expertise to TDEC and to the permanent Household Hazardous Waste Facilities. In June 2014, SWA conducted site visits of the four existing HHW facilities located in Nashville, Memphis, Knoxville and Chattanooga to review operations, evaluate facility design, and interview facility operators. The objectives of the visits and interviews were to identify improvements opportunities for current operations and design and provide written recommendations to include operating efficiency, potential operating cost reductions, increased waste diversion, review of training programs, and increased level of compliance with best practices and key permit requirements. In FY 2015, the reports were presented by TDEC to each of HHW facility managers and staff to determine which of the recommendations were a priority. Each local government researched costs and the Department allocated \$1,000,000 for the HHW Operation and Maintenance Grant to assist in implementing enhanced operations and recommended facility improvements. Total operations funding is \$400,000. Total maintenance funding is \$600,000. Grant applications shall be reviewed and evaluated in December 2015 with executed grants to be issued in FY 2016.

Waste Tire Cleanup

The Waste Tire Cleanup Grant was developed to assist counties with clean up and remediation of unpermitted waste tire disposal sites.

In FY 2014-2015, a waste tire cleanup for the Nolichucky River started. This project is scheduled to be completed in 2016 and will be included with more detail in next year's report.

Old Closed Landfill Grant

The Old Closed Landfill grant is offered to local governments for investigation and corrective action of unlined Class I landfills that have been identified as causing contamination of ground water and harm to health or the environment. Applicants are reimbursed for not more than 50% of the total eligible corrective action costs up to the availability of funds for this grant. Counties or municipalities that operated a Class I landfill permitted by TDEC are eligible for this grant offering.

DSWM solicited corrective action projects for Old Closed Landfills that were contaminating groundwater. Four landfills were identified as eligible for this grant. The four landfills and project costs are below.

TDEC contracts with the Development Districts to provide technical assistance for solid waste planning. The districts prepare and submit work plans that outline technical assistance for the regions in their district. This is a non-matching grant. In FY 2014-2015, nine Development Districts were awarded \$320,057 to provide technical assistance services for planning activities authorized by the SWMA.

2025 SOLID WASTE AND MATERIALS MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

TDEC implemented the 2025 Solid Waste and Materials Management Plan in 2015. This plan adopts the concept of sustainable materials management and includes 8 objectives that will be implemented over the next 10 years. This section of the report discusses current plan implementation. CONCLUSION

Tennessee has made significant progress since the passing of the Solid Waste Management Act of 1991 and its subsequent amendments. The data provided in this report represents that Tennessee has achieved an intermediate status level in establishing its solid waste and materials management systems. Sixty-five of the sixty-six Solid Waste Regions achieved or exceeded the 25% waste reduction and diversion goal. Collectively, the state averaged a 30% waste reduction and diversion effort.

The new 2025 Solid Waste and Materials Management Plan provides a roadmap to move the state towards a more advanced system that helps communities succeed in managing commodities to their best highest use, to exceed current goals, and to establish new more challenging goals. It is time to evaluate the establishment of a new goal that challenges the state to move the mark and push more materials into the recovered materials systems. Tennessee still landfills a significant amount of materials that could be used as feedstock for Tennessee commerce and manufacturing. Opportunity exists to create new partnerships between the public and private sectors in capturing these materials and upcycling them into the economy to create and sustain new and current jobs, relieve pressures on landfill capacity, and better protect the environment. Achieving the objectives of the 2025 Plan will be a sound step towards achieving an advanced integrated solid waste management system in Tennessee.
