

# Backflow Prevention Assembly Repair Class

## Who should attend?

Individuals working in water systems who are involved in backflow prevention programs, plumbers, employees of industries and institutions, irrigation personnel, and fire protection system personnel.

Any persons interested in backflow prevention assemblies are welcome to attend. However, these courses are designed for certified backflow testers.

## Course Description

The course will teach participants how to repair backflow prevention assemblies made by various manufacturers. Detailed information will be provided on the maintenance and repair of Reduced Pressure Principle assemblies and Double Check Valve assemblies.

## Major Topics Include

- Repair of varying sized assemblies ranging from 3/4" to 10"
- Explanation of assembly components and parts used in repair
- Complete repair of device and tools needed
- When to repair and when to replace
- What should be replaced when a device fails

## Registration

Pre-registration is required. Registration forms should be submitted at least **thirty (30) days** in advance of the class. Enrollment may be limited, and is on a first come, first-available basis.

## Course Length

The course is one (1) class day.

## Experience Credit

This course is not eligible for experience credit.

## Continuing Education
