The work is to be constructed under one contract and generally includes the following:

- Rehabilitation of 213 LF of existing 6-inch gravity sewer using cured-in-place pipe lining methods;
- Rehabilitation of 4,568 LF of existing 8-inch gravity sewer using cured-in-place pipe lining methods;
- Rehabilitation of 21 manholes; and
- Rehabilitation of approximately 60 sewer service connections and associated sewer service laterals by cured-in-place pipe lining and open trench methods.

The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All bidders must be licensed General Contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1994 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
