

TENNESSEE BOARD OF ATHLETIC TRAINERS
POSITION STATEMENT REGARDING “PERSONS” AGAINST WHOM
THE BOARD MAY ASSESS CIVIL PENALTIES

It is the position of the Tennessee Board of Athletic Trainers that the word “persons” as used in T.C.A. § 63-24-101(c) refers to all “persons” who have legal rights and obligations under Tennessee and federal law, including but not limited to natural persons, licensed facilities, corporations and other legally recognized business entities.

The Board has statutory authority to assess civil penalties commensurate with those assessable under § 63-1-134 against persons who have knowingly employed, contracted for or otherwise utilized unlicensed persons in the practice of athletic training, with or without compensation.
