Hourly Vaccine Temperature Log – Fahrenheit Refrigerated

Refrigerated vaccines must be maintained between 36°F and 46°F.

Call TIP immediately if vaccine is exposed to temperature below 36°F for more than 15 minutes or above 46°F for more than 60 minutes. Take the below actions:

1. Label vaccine “do not use”
2. Store vaccine under proper conditions as quickly as possible
3. Notify TIP at 1-800-404-3006

Frozen vaccine must be maintained between -58°F and 5°F.

Call TIP immediately if vaccine is exposed to temperature above 5°F for more than 60 minutes. Take the below actions:

1. Label vaccine “do not use”
2. Store vaccine under proper conditions as quickly as possible
3. Notify TIP at 1-800-404-3006
