Duties include presiding over and conducting driver points hearings, driver financial responsibility hearings, driver medical hearings and other driver license issue hearings; rendering the appropriate decisions and preparing written Initial Orders in accordance with state Administrative Laws. Duties also include serving as an Attorney within the Legal Division, handling asset forfeiture hearings in Chattanooga and other districts as needed.

The Attorney must be currently licensed to practice law in the State of Tennessee.
