
Performance Model Policy 3.200

The Background:

The State Board of Education adopted the Performance Model Policy in April 2000. This policy, which has not been updated since 2009, established performance goals and sets forth various indicators and measures for school performance.

The State Board now adopts annual performance goals and objectives for achievement and achievement gap closure annually making this policy outdated and obsolete. As such, it is recommended that this policy be repealed.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

The Recommendation:

The Department of Education recommends acceptance of this item on first reading. The SBE staff concurs with this recommendation.
