



Lebanon Town Square Reconstruction

Contractor: Civil Constructors, Inc.

Project Summary

TDOT plans to change the Lebanon Town Square, located at US 231 (Cumberland Street) and US 70 (Main Street) in Wilson County, from its existing configuration to a traditional roundabout. This change calls for the removal of parking spaces surrounding the statue of General Robert Hatton in the center of the square and adds parking at each corner of the square. Specialty signing and pavement markings will be added. Enhanced lighting, landscaping, and drainage improvements will also be part of the construction.

The planned project is the result of a safety study, requested by local officials. An aggressive project design schedule allowed the much-anticipated project to be let to construction in July 2015, with work expected to begin shortly thereafter.

Reconstruction of the square is designed to improve safety, create a more pedestrian-friendly environment, and revitalize the city square.

The \$1 million project will be funded with state and local dollars.



Project Timeline

October 2014 – Phase 1 begins

- construction signs posted
- parking eliminated from center
- inner travel lanes milled
- inner square reconstructed

December 2014 – Construction limited

January 2015 – Phase 2 begins

- outer square reconstructed
- work to begin in southwest corner
- work to continue in clockwise direction

June 2015 – Construction ends

- Nightly lane closures are possible during construction.
