

**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT**  
**STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is seeking comments on Amendment #73, #74, #75 to the 2014-2017 State Transportation Improvement Program.

Amendment #73 Project Number 1460003 is to be deleted from the 2014-2017 Rural portion of the State Transportation Improvement Program. The project consisted of modifying the interchange at Interstate 65 and State Route 99 US-412 in Maury County. It was a TDOT sponsored project.

Amendment #74 Project Number 1460005 is to be deleted from the 2014-2017 Rural portion of the STIP. The project consisted of improving streetscape and pavement repair in Maury County, and the County was the lead agency.

Amendment #75 Project Number 1460010 is to be deleted from the 2014-2017 Rural portion of the STIP. The project consisted of constructing a new interchange at State Route 6 and State Route 166 in Mount Pleasant, Maury County. It was a TDOT sponsored project.

After the projects were initially amended into the STIP, the Nashville Metropolitan Planning Organization expanded its planning area to include all of Maury County. Therefore, they no longer qualify for listing in the STIP and must be removed from it through the amendment process. Once these amendments are approved by the Federal Highway Administration, TDOT will request the Nashville MPO to amend Project Numbers 1460003 and 1460010 into the Regional Plan as needed and into the MPO's 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program. Maury County officials will separately determine the future of Project Number 1460005 with MPO staff.

The public is being asked to review this document and provide comments to TDOT within 15 days of this publication date. After 15 days, the comments and suggestions will be reviewed and incorporated into the plan as appropriate.
