Today I was made aware of a new requirement for the 911 Districts, as well as the other governmental entities, to comply with the Ethics Reform Act. Our Board adopted an ethics policy in 2005 that I have attached. However, after reviewing our policy, I do not believe it entirely meets the guidelines under the Reform Act and will need to be revised.

Our Board just met on Wednesday of this week and is not scheduled to meet again until August 15th. I will be in contact with Board members prior to that date to try and draft a new resolution for their review and approval but I will not be able to finalize the approval until our August meeting. I would like to request an extension until August 30th.

This email is a good faith attempt to comply with the law. I appreciate any information or assistance you can provide concerning this matter.
