The first Becoming an Outdoors-Woman (BOW) workshop started in 1991 as an experiment to determine whether providing an educational opportunity would be enough to welcome women outdoors.

Since 1991, the program has expanded to over 40 states and several Canadian provinces, with many offering multiple opportunities. Women are interested in learning outdoor skills. When the opportunity is offered, they line up for the chance to be involved.

The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency hosts several BOW and Beyond BOW events every year. Tennessee events include a yearly canoe trip down the Hiwassee River, muzzleloader workshops, and an entire weekend workshop filled with classes and activities every aspiring outdoors-woman will enjoy. Some of these classes include Basic Archery, Reading The Woods, ATV Operation, Dutch Oven Cooking, Fly-fishing, Nature Photography, and much, much more.

ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE WORKSHOP

A "Beyond BOW" Program

Come ride the ATV trails of the Tennessee Wildlife Management Area called Royal Blue and Sundquist. Over 130,000 acres and 430 miles of mountain trails await you, with varying degrees of difficulty. Due to the terrain, prior ATV riding experience is mandatory. Located 45 miles north of Knoxville, the workshop will be held at RideRoyalBlue.com ATV Guest Resort & Campground, located in the heart of the Cumberland Mountains of East Tennessee.

The cost of the workshop is \$150 which includes lodging for two nights, meals, WMA permit, ATV, and required safety equipment. If you have your own ATV you are welcome to bring it.

Participants will check in the evening of September 11. Dinner is provided.

The cabins sleep four people (two sets of bunk beds) and are equipped with heating and air conditioning. The bath and shower facilities are a short hike away.

Following breakfast on Saturday morning, there will be approximately a 1-hour ATV safety/orientation course and then we will head for the trails.

After riding for a few hours, we will have lunch at one of TWRA's elk viewing towers and hopefully catch a glimpse or possibly hear a bugle from one of these magnificent animals.

We will then ride the trails that afternoon, making our way back to the resort, where dinner will be served, accompanied by some live music.

On Sunday, breakfast will be provided and then we will depart for home.


