Holston Army Ammunitions Plant (HAAP) Waterfowl Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70 Tennessee Code Annotated Section 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a waterfowl refuge to be known as Holston Army Ammunitions Plant (HAAP) Waterfowl Refuge.

Those waters of the Holston River in Hawkins and Sullivan counties beginning at the downstream bisect of the Holston Army Ammunition Plant (HAAP) property line and the Holston River (Approximately HRM 136.3) and continuing upstream to the Inter-Plant Railroad Bridge (HRM 141.2). These described properties are closed to all forms of ~~trespass from November 15th~~ hunting from the 4<sup>th</sup> (fourth) Saturday of August thru the last day of February. Properties within the described boundaries owned by the Holston Army Ammunitions Plant (Department of Defense) are closed year round to the public, except for special events and hunts conducted by the Holston Army Ammunitions Plant Natural Resources Manager.
