## Steps for obtaining a TDA Food Manufacturing Permit

- The first step to obtain a food manufacturing permit is to complete and submit the Food Manufacturer Application.

- Once the completed application is reviewed and processed a TDA inspector will contact to set up the day and time of the initial inspection.
- Food Manufacturers are regulated under 21 CFR Parts A and B. Although all aspects of this regulation are applicable below must be confirmed during the inspection:
  - All equipment is in place and functioning correctly
  - Hot water is available at hand sinks
  - Floors, walls, ceilings are smooth, durable and easily cleanable
  - Outer openings are protected from pest entry
  - Sanitation chemicals are on site
  - Processing must be conducted during the inspection
  - Labels must include all required information
  - Ingredients must come from approved sources
  - Primary packaging is approved for food contact
- After the completion of a passing inspection the firm will be invoiced for the appropriate permit fee. Once the fee has been paid the permit will be sent via mail.
- Permits must be renewed annually and run from July 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> each year.
