Board of Parole's First 2020 Meeting to be held in Nashville Jan. 29 at 404 James Robertson Parkway, Suite 1300

NASHVILLE – The Tennessee Board of Parole will hold its first 2020 administrative board meeting at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 29 at 404 James Robertson Parkway in the Charles Traughber Board Room, located on the 13th floor in downtown Nashville.

The meeting is open to the public. Individuals interested in addressing the board should arrive early in order to be placed on the agenda.

The next administrative meeting is scheduled for June 24.

The Board of Parole is an independent seven-member board whose members are appointed by the Governor. The Board makes decisions about which eligible offenders will be granted parole and placed on community supervision for the remainder of their sentences. The Board also can revoke parole of those offenders who do not abide by the conditions of their supervision. In addition, the Board reviews applications for executive clemency and makes non-binding recommendations to the Governor.
