PROJECT OVERVIEW

The State of Tennessee has a history of leadership in the national 911 community in areas of technology and management. Tennessee is working to continue that legacy of excellence through our training program. The Tennessee Emergency Communication Board (TECB) is focused on offering 911 training initiatives that ensure District and Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) leadership and telecommunicators have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to improve emergency response outcomes. These training opportunities are made available through both the Virtual Academy online training program and in-person classroom offerings.

WHO IS IMPACTED

Governmental PSAPs that take initial or transferred 911 calls can take advantage of the training opportunities offered online or in-person.

TECB TRAINING COORDINATOR ACTIVITY

Over the last few months, the Training Coordinator has met 19 Emergency Communications District (ECD) Directors and conducted three site visits. TECB has a Communications Training Officer (CTO), onthe-job training program template in development. It will offer ECDs and PSAPs the opportunity to document and track the training progress for new employees during onthe-job training.


VIRTUAL ACADEMY
