ORDER ADOPTING EXAMINATION REPORT WITH DIRECTIVES

As a result of an examination conducted as of the 31st day of December, 2007, the examiner-in-charge filed with the Division, on the 5th day of June, 2009, a verified, written report on the examination, and a copy of that report has been sent to the Company. (The Report on Examination of the Company is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A). The Division received no written rebuttal to said examination report from the Company. The Company waived any right to rebuttal with respect to the Report on Examination of the Paratransit Insurance Company, a Mutual Risk Retention Group filed with the Division, on the 23rd day of June, 2009. (The letter waiving rebuttal is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit B.)

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 56-1-411, said examination report regarding the affairs of the Paratransit Insurance Company, a Mutual Risk Retention Group, filed with the Insurance Division of the State of Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance on the 5th day of June, 2009, is hereby **ADOPTED** as filed with the following **DIRECTIVE**:

1. The Company is **DIRECTED** to comply with NAIC Statement of Statutory Accounting Principals SSAP # 53 by not classifying anticipated premium audit adjustment payments received from insured members as advance premiums.

The company shall comply with the directives contained in this order within thirty (30) days of its entry.

The adoption of this examination report shall not preclude the Department from imposing sanctions against the Paratransit Insurance Company, a Mutual Risk Retention Group for potential violations of the Tennessee Insurance Law which may be revealed in the examination report, it being the intent of this Order Adopting Examination Report With Directives merely to adopt the examination report filed by the examiner-in-charge.
