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## **YOUR LICENSE!** By Mark H. Crocker, CPA

t's December 31 and your license to practice accountancy in Tennessee is about to expire – have you renewed it or not? Did your spouse



remember to send it in when paying the bills? Did the office staff process your renewal along with all of the other professionals?

Who renews this year? All of the even-numbered licensees will renew. If your personal license ends in a 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8 then your license expires on December 31, 2010. One of the most common misconceptions we encounter is the idea that 'Inactive' or 'Retired' license holders do not have to renew. WRONG! Having an 'Inactive' or 'Retired' status means that you do not have to meet the CPE requirements or pay the Professional Privilege Tax, but you DO have to renew your license every two years. If your license is in a status of 'Retired Over 70,' then you may relax on the beach and not worry about renewing as those licensees are exempt from CPE, Professional Privilege Tax and renewal fees.

In addition, ALL firm permits expire on December 31, so be sure to renew your firm permit as well.

### SQCS No. 7: A Firm's System of Quality Control By Stanley Sawyer, CPA, Chairman - TNSBA

fundamental tool in your accounting and audit practice is Quality Control Policies and Procedures (QCPP). QCPP protects and limits risk in malpractice suits and demonstrates the firm's compliance with professional standards and



applicable regulatory and legal standards. It also ensures the reports issued by the firm are appropriate in the circumstances.

In September 2005, the AICPA commissioned a Task Force through the Auditing Standards Board (ASB) to review the Statements of Quality Control Standards (SQCS) to determine if they were adequate, in light of the changes in the quality control environment, with an overall goal of bringing them into harmony with the International Statement of Quality Control Standard No.1.

The task force included members from the ASB, Accounting and Review Services Committee, the Peer Review Board and the Center for Public Companies Audit Firms Peer Review Committee.

In accordance with the recommendations of the task force, on October 10, 2007, the ASB issued SQCS No. 7; A FIRM'S SYSTEM OF QUALITY CONTROL with an effective date of January 1, 2009. SQCS No. 7 does not address the quality-control ramifications of Sarbanes-Oxley of 2002 or Public Company Accounting Oversight Board (PCAOB) standards nor does it modify the system of quality control to conform to PCAOB standards.

#### What Does SQCS No. 7 do?

- 1. It replaces all existing SQSC and establishes standards and provides guidance for a CPA Firm's responsibilities for its system of quality control for its accounting and auditing practice.
- 2. It essentially changes the elements of quality control and describes them

along with other matters essential to the design implementation and maintenance of an effective system.

- 3. It sets forth the meaning of certain terms to describe the professional requirements imposed on firms and practitioners in charge.
- 4. It deals in depth with a CPA Firm's quality control practices in the areas of audits, reviews, compilations and other attest engagements.
- 5. SQCS No. 7 places an unconditional obligation on a firm to establish a system of quality control designed to provide reasonable assurance that a firm and its personnel comply with professional standards, applicable regulatory and legal requirements.

## The major differences from SQCS effective through December 31, 2008 are:

- 1. It defines the term "engagement quality review."
- 2. It requires firms to establish criteria for which engagements are subject to an engagement quality control review.
- 3. It provides guidance is provided on policies and procedures for performing engagement quality control reviews.
- 4. It defines terminology to describe the degree of responsibility imposed on firms with two categories of requirements:
  - a. Unconditional requirements refers to use of words "must" or "is required" to indicate an unconditional requirement to comply with in all cases in which a circumstance exist.
  - b. Presumptively mandatory requirement – required to comply with in all cases in which a circumstance exists.

## Additionally, SQCS No. 7 imposes the following:

- 1. Requires a firm to document its quality control policies and procedures. The extent of the documentation is based on the size, structure, and nature of the firm's practice.
- 2. Requires a firm's system of quality control to address each of the following elements:
  - a. Leadership responsibilities for quality within the firm (tone at the top).
  - b. Ethical requirements.
  - c. Acceptance and continuance of client relationships and specific engagements.
  - d. Human resources.
  - e. Engagement performance and documentation.
  - f. Monitoring and
  - g. Assignment of management responsibilities so that commercial considerations do not override the objectives of the system of quality control.
- 3. Provides more detailed guidance on independence and requires a written confirmation of compliance with independence from all firm personnel at least annually. A firm may obtain this confirmation on an engagementby-engagement basis.
- 4. Provides more detailed guidance on engagement supervision and review, engagement documentation, and consultation policies and procedures.
- 5. Requires policies and procedures for resolving differences of opinion, including a requirement that reports must not be issued until the differences of opinion are resolved.
- 6. Requires annual monitoring procedures, which include one or more of the following:

- a. Engagement quality control reviews
- b. Post issuance reviews
- c. Inspection procedures
- 7. Requires firms to assign responsibility for monitoring to a person of appropriate authority, who is required to evaluate deficiencies and communicate recommendations for remedial action.
- 8. Requires firms to establish policies and procedures for dealing appropriately with complaints and allegations of non-compliance with professional standards or with the firm's system of quality control.

What needs to be done to comply with the SQCS No. 7? Each firm must tailor its practices and policies to its size and mix of clients. Some best practices and policies include the following:

Requiring engagements to have an Engagement Quality Control Review for any engagement in the public interest where fraud or illegal activity is alleged and when required by law or regulation.

## Suggested procedures required for all engagement quality control reviews include:

- 1. Discussion of significant accounting, auditing and financial reporting issues noted during the engagement.
- Discussion concerning the presence of audit high-risk assertions, transactions, and account balances.
- 3. Confirmation that there are no unresolved significant issues.
- 4. Review of selected working papers relating to significant judgments made.
- 5. Review of documentation of resolution of significant auditing, accounting, or financial reporting issues including consultation documentation.
- 6. Review of summary of uncorrected misstatements related to known and

likely misstatements.

- Review of additional engagement documentation to the extent necessary.
- 8. Reading of the financial statements and report and consideration of whether the report is appropriate.
- 9. Complete the review before the release of the report.
- 10. Determination of whether the issues raised in the review indicate a need to change the auditor's report date.
- 11. Resolution by the managing partner to resolve any conflicting opinions between the engagement partners and the engagement quality control reviewer regarding significant issues.

#### The suggested documentation at the completion of an engagement quality control review includes ensuring that:

- 1. The required procedures have been performed.
- 2. The engagement quality control review was completed before the report was released.
- 3. No matters have come to the attention of the engagement quality control review that would prohibit the issuance of the report.
- 4. The firm has established criteria for the eligibility of engagement quality control reviewers.
- 5. Engagement selection is made by quality control partner or managing partner.
- 6. Reviewer has sufficient technical expertise and experience.
- 7. The firm carries out responsibilities with objectivity and due professional care.
- 8. The firm meets the independence requirements.
- 9. The partner in charge does not make decisions for the assigned team or participate in the engagement except the partner in charge may consult with the quality control reviewer at any stage of the engagement.

SQCS No. 7 provides the guidance

for a firm to fulfill its responsibility to design a system of quality control to ensure that the firm and the firm's personnel comply with professional standards and applicable regulatory and legal requirements and implement procedures to monitor compliance. The elements of quality control described in SQSC No. 7 are indispensable in developing effective Quality Control Policies and Procedures.

He is a member of both the AICPA and TSCPA and is a past president of the TSCPA. Casey and his wife Susan have two children and live on Signal Mountain.

## PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Board of Accountancy has created a Law and Rules Committee to continuously review the law and rules pertaining to the practice of public accountancy in the State of Tennessee. Changes are happening at a rapid pace in our profession as well our society and our technology. In order to make our statutes and the associated rules stay current, changes must be made on a fairly regular basis. The Board has considered the following revisions and proposes that they be implemented as soon as possible.

Licensees have requested that the Board reconsider the four (4) hour ethics CPE requirement. The Board is responding to that concern with a rule change that will eliminate the four (4) hour requirement every renewal cycle, and reduce the number of ethics CPE hours to two (2). However, the two (2) hours of ethics CPE required every renewal cycle will be State Specific with no general ethics component. Implementation for this change will more than likely effect those licensees renewing their licenses in 2112. Currently, a candidate for licensure must have completed twenty-four (24) semester hours in accounting and twentyfour (24) semester hours in general business courses. That requirement is being changed to thirty (30) semester hours in accounting education, with at least twenty-four (24) of those hours in upper division courses. The requirement for general business education is not affected by the change.

In keeping with current technology, the Board is also making a change to require licensees to notify the Board upon the change of e-mail address. Our licensees are currently required to notify the Board office of any change in address and/or employer, but many of our recent licensees prefer to receive notifications via e-mail. However, if the e-mail address changes and the file is not updated, then any information sent via e-mail is returned or goes into cyberspace! The Board is making a good faith effort to keep up with our licensees and to stay in contact, so an updated e-mail address requirement should be beneficial to the licensee as well as to the Board staff.

Finally, there is some 'cleanup' language proposed for the section of the rules on peer review because the Board no longer operates a peer review program. Requirements for compliance with the TSCPA and/or the AICPA peer review programs present a different timeline than that mandated by the rules currently in place. In addition, because the Board no longer offers a program, a rule is being implemented to require that a firm be enrolled in a Board approved peer review program in order to maintain a firm permit in good standing and to avoid a complaint.

We are anticipating a rule-making hearing at the Board meeting in January to make these proposed changes final. If you have comments or concerns on these proposals, please contact the Board office in writing. Any input is welcome and will be considered at the meeting. Remember, these changes have an effect on your CPA license, and your comments could really make a difference.

## **Quick Review of License Renewal**

## How is the licensee notified that the license needs to be renewed?

• License renewal postcards are mailed to the TNSBA mailing address of record to all CPAs, PAs and Firms needing to renew their licenses by 12-31-10.

#### Who Needs to Renew by 12-31-10?

- CPAs and PAs with license numbers ending in even numbers
- All CPA firms

#### What is the license renewal fee?

- CPAs and PAs fee is \$120.00 (if paid by 12-31-10)
- CPA Firms fee is \$50.00 (if paid by 12-31-10)

#### How is payment made?

• The easiest method is to pay online at: <u>http://www.tennesseeanytime.org/cirens</u> using your license number (no leading zeros) and the ZIP code TNSBA has on file for your mailing address • Alternatively you may request a paper invoice by calling the automated system at 1- 866-283-6191. You will need to allow at least three (3) weeks for the invoice to be generated and mailed to you. You will need to know a 4-digit number that tells the automated system you are a CPA (1101), PA (1102) or Firm (1103), and your license number (no leading zeros). The form will be mailed to your mailing address of record.

#### Is that all there is to renew a license?

- Yes for CPAs, PAs and **SOME** Firms (sole proprietorships with no CPA employees who do not perform attest services).
- Not for many firms that are required to provide firm ownership, employee, and other state license information by submitting the form located at the back of this newsletter or accessed at:<u>http://tn.gov/commerce/boards/tnsba/</u> documents/Consolidationattachmentsabcd.pdf

Please Note: All requirements for license renewal must be received in the TNSBA office on or before December 31, 2010.



## SSARS No. 19, Compilation and Review Engagements Issued by AICPA

On December 30, 2009, the AICPA's Accounting and Review Services Committee (ARSC) issued a new compilation and review standard that includes the most significant changes since 1978.

Statement on Standards for Accounting and Review Services (SSARS) No. 19, *Compilation and Review Engagements*, is effective for periods ending on or after December 15, 2010, with the exception of Paragraph 2.21, which may be implemented early.

Paragraph 2.21 states in part, "The accountant is not precluded from disclosing a description about the reason(s) that his or her independence is impaired."

This amendment allows CPAs to explain in their compilation reports the reasons why they are not independent. CPAs can either continue to merely say they are not independent or, if they choose, they can now describe the reasons for the independence impairment.

Another significant change is that the new standard separates the compilation guidance from the review guidance. Other significant changes include:

- A discussion of how the accountant obtains limited assurance through the performance of review procedures;
- The introduction of the term *review evidence* to the review literature;
- A discussion of tailoring the review procedures based on

the accountant's understanding of the client's industry, knowledge of the client, and awareness of the risk that he or she may unknowingly fail to modify the accountant's review report on financial statements that are materially misstated;

- A discussion of materiality in the context of a review engagement;
- A requirement that an accountant document the establishment of an understanding with management through a written communication (that is, an engagement letter) regarding the services to be performed; and
- The establishment of enhanced documentation requirements for compilation and review engagements.

To assist practitioners with the provisions of Paragraph 2.21 of SSARS No. 19, the AICPA has issued a paper which discusses, in question and answer format, this specific paragraph and the alternatives now available to practitioners. 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## A Word on Carry-Forward CPE

There may be some confusion among licensees about how carryforward CPE works. The Board of Accountancy's Rule 0020-5-.03(1)(e) states: "Up to twenty-four (24) CPE hours taken in excess of the eighty (80) hour requirement for each two year period may be applied to the requirement of the next succeeding two year renewal cycle."

Therefore, if 96 hours of CPE were completed in licensing period one, 16 hours may be carried forward to licensing period two. If only 76 hours were actually completed in the following 2 year period, a portion of those extra (16) hours from licensing period one may be used to reach the 80 minimum CPE requirement for licensing period two. However, no hours may be carried forward into licensing period three, since less than 80 hours were actually completed in licensing period two.

Other information of note:

1. Carry-forward hours cannot be used to meet the 20 hour

minimum annual CPE requirement

- Carry-forward hours cannot be used to meet the 40 hour technical CPE requirement since these hours are defined as "other" not "technical" hours no matter how they were classified when completed during the preceding licensing period.
- 3. Carry-forward hours (as stated above) carry forward only one licensing period.

## **CHANGE OF ADDRESS** *Important Housekeeping Information*

In the back of this issue of the *Balance Sheet* there is a Change of Address form for CPAs and PAs. TNSBA sends all correspondence and renewal notices to your Mailing Address of record and also keeps your home address and employment address on file.

The renewal postcards have been mailed to licensees whose licenses expire 12-31-10. If you had not notified TNSBA of an address change by October 18, 2010 and your license number ends with an even digit, that license renewal postcard may not get to you. Sadly, you probably did not receive this newsletter either, but maybe you are now reading a colleague's copy.

If your addresses (mailing, home and employment) have changed, please advise TNSBA so that our records reflect your correct contacts. Addresses may be changed on-line during the license renewal process or by sending the change of address form in this newsletter. Even if you are not required to renew your license by 12-31-10 you may go into the license renewal program and make address changes. The license renewal program is found at:

#### Protect Your License...cont.

There is a new feature in the firm renewal process this year – if the firm is a sole proprietorship with no CPA employees, then you may complete the entire renewal process online without sending in additional paperwork. Be sure to read the complete instructions so that the process may be completed properly. A quick summary of the steps necessary to renew online is provided in this newsletter. Please take a moment to review it and then get online!

It is important that your license and

firm permit be renewed in a timely manner. Performing or offering to perform accounting services requires an active license and those services must be performed by a registered accounting firm. If either the personal license or the firm permit is in a 'Delinquent' status at the time the work is performed, then the work is being performed without proper licensure and disciplinary action is likely to follow.

So, get your credit card out, login, and renew those licenses now! You'll be able to start the new year knowing that you are in good standing with the State Board of Accountancy!

### **CPA** Renewals

All even number licenses must be renewed by December 31, 2010.
