### **ENGAGEMENT LETTERS:** An Essential Risk Management Tool

s the accounting profession takes on more roles in order to remain competitive, lawsuits now delve into a wider range of issues. Where once they were largely generated by tax and audit work, now they also derive from compilation and review, write-up, and management advisory services.

Many lawsuits involving CPAs are the result of a communication breakdown (or "expectation gap") between the CPA and the client. In many situations, the client's understanding of the scope of services to be performed and how the work product will be utilized may be quite different from the CPA's understanding of these issues.

Although engagement letters are not required legally, they are strongly encouraged. A properly drafted engagement letter can serve as a helpful risk-management

tool by establishing a legal framework for a working relationship with a client.

While the engagement letter itself may vary with the level of service or type of engagement to be provided, common provisions in most engagement letters include the following:

- Identification of client;
- Description of the engagement and its limitations:
- Timing of the work and staffing of the engagement;
- Client information and responsibilities;
- Designation of the party to work with the CPA;
- Identification of intended users of the CPA's work product;
- · Fees and payments;
- Withdrawing from and/or terminating the engagement;
- Responding to discovery requests, subpoenas, and outside inquiries;
- Alternative dispute resolution as a means of resolving disputes;
- Where applicable, disclosures recommended or required by the AICPA; and
- · Client signature.

#### **Identification of Client**

A properly drafted engagement letter should identify who will receive the CPA's services. The CPA may be working for an individual, a group, an entity, or a portion of an entity. For example, if the CPA's client is a corporation that has subsidiaries or other corporate affiliations, it may be necessary to identify the entities to be included in the engagement.

## **Description and Limitations of Work to Be Performed**

The engagement letter should indicate what services are to be rendered. In general, the CPA should

outline the procedures to be performed and any reports to be issued. In so doing, the engagement letter can help guard against the client developing unreasonable expectations about the nature and the scope of the services to be provided.

#### Timing of Work and Staffing of Engagement

This section of the engagement letter varies by the type of engagement and indicates when the engagement will begin and end.

For example, an audit engagement may contain a provision indicating the date fieldwork will begin and end and possibly an expected date of delivery of the audit report.

A tax engagement may contain a provision indicating any known filing deadlines and the parties' understanding concerning the use of extensions should the information not be received by the CPA to timely prepare the return.

Some CPA firms may indicate who will be staffing the engagement. This provision may prove helpful, for example, where a client expects to work with certain employees of the CPA firm.

## **Client Information and Responsibilities**

In most engagements, the client is required to collect certain information and provide certain records to the CPA. If this information is necessary for the CPA to complete the engagement, these client responsibilities, and any applicable deadlines for the completion of work by the client, should be described.

For example, a tax engagement would normally contain a provision indicating it is the client's responsibility to sign and file tax returns prepared by the CPA, along with an explanation of the consequences of the client's failure to sign and file such returns.

## Designation of the Party to Work with the CPA

Some engagement letters request the client to designate the party to work

with the CPA. This provision can help the CPA avoid situations in which conflicting requests or instructions are received from more than one of the client's employees.

#### **Identification of Intended Users of the CPA's Work Product**

In some jurisdictions, a CPA can limit or avoid liability to third parties by identifying in the engagement letter the intended users of the work product. In addition to identifying these users, this provision often contains language prohibiting the client from distributing the CPA's work product to any party other than these users.

In deciding whether the engagement letter should contain this provision, competent legal counsel should be consulted. This is especially true for jurisdictions which have privity standards for establishing auditor negligence.

#### **Fees and Payments**

An engagement letter can help avoid fee disputes before the work begins. This section of the letter details how and when the client will be billed. It may describe the amount of retainer (if any); how the fee will be computed; when payment will become due; the client's obligation to pay promptly; and the CPA's rights should the client fail to give prompt payment.

In some cases, the CPA may charge interest for late payments. In more extreme cases, it may be necessary for the CPA to suspend work or cancel the engagement for fees not paid.

#### Withdrawing From or Terminating the Engagement

At times, it may be necessary for the CPA to withdraw from the engagement. The engagement letter should outline the conditions that might lead to the CPA's withdrawal and the procedures the CPA will follow in case of withdrawal.

Examples of situations in which the CPA's withdrawal from the engagement

may be required include issues of conflict of interest; management ethics or integrity; or the CPA's real or apparent lack of independence.

This section should also discuss policies and procedures related to the termination of the engagement including return of client files; preparation of the final bill; work paper retention; and date of termination of services.

#### Responding to Discovery Requests, Subpoenas, and Outside Inquiries

Occasionally, a CPA may receive a discovery request, subpoena, or outside inquiry. While several states have established a CPA/client privilege with respect to communications, most states do not have such a privilege.

Moreover, there is no federal CPA/client privilege with the specific exception relating to tax planning. This section of the engagement letter can help avoid future misunderstandings between the client and the CPA regarding whether, and to what extent, the CPA may be required to respond to such requests.

#### **Alternative Dispute Resolution**

Alternative dispute resolution (ADR) refers to methods of resolving disputes outside of the courtroom. One of these methods is known as arbitration.

In arbitration, the opposing parties select one or more arbitrators who decide the outcome of the dispute. In most cases, the decision of the arbitrator cannot be appealed. Typically, the pre-arbitration discovery process is limited, and third parties are not bound by the arbitrator's decision.

Another method of resolving disputes outside of a court of law is mediation. During mediation, a mediator attempts to find the "common ground" that exists between the opposing parties that may lead to a mutually agreed-upon settlement. In the

event the mediation is not successful, the parties, if they so desire, may litigate their dispute.

Before inserting a provision in the engagement letter regarding alternative dispute resolution, a CPA should consult with legal counsel regarding the provision's enforceability.

In addition, inserting a provision concerning alternative dispute resolution in an engagement letter may have insurance coverage implications.

For example, while some insurers encourage the use of mediation, under some policies the use of an arbitration clause may limit or void the CPA's professional liability insurance coverage for any claims that are arbitrated.

## Disclosures Recommended or Required by the AICPA

The AICPA recommends the inclusion in an engagement letter of certain disclosures for certain types of engagements. These disclosures may be incorporated into, or have an effect upon, other provisions of the engagement letter.

#### **Client Signature**

This section should request the client sign and return an executed copy of the engagement letter to the CPA. It should provide that if the client does not agree that the engagement letter accurately reflects the agreement of the parties to the engagement, the client will promptly notify the CPA.

If the client does not return a signed engagement letter, the CPA may send a certified letter indicating that, unless otherwise notified, the CPA will assume the client agrees to the terms of the engagement letter or the CPA may recuse himself or herself from the engagement. In any event, the most effective engagement letter is one signed by the client before the CPA begins the engagement.

## CHANGES COMING TO THE RULES!

Tennessee Code Annotated Section 62-1-105(e) empowers the Board of Accountancy to promulgate rules governing its administration and the conduct of its licensees. Our profession and the environment in which we operate is always changing, and therefore our laws and rules also need to be updated periodically. The Law and Rules Committee of the Board of Accountancy meets prior to every Board meeting to discuss any changes that may need to be made in statute or rule in order to more efficiently regulate our profession.


When changes do need to be made, proposed rule changes are posted to the Board website, along with a 60 day notice of an upcoming rulemaking hearing. The rulemaking hearing is held in the presence of the full Board and anyone who wishes to speak to the proposed changes will be heard at that time. Any written comments received by the Board will be read into the minutes as well.

Upon approval by the Board, the rule changes are sent to the Attorney General's office for review. The Attorney General will ensure that the proposed rules do not conflict with existing statutes. The rule changes are then sent to the Office of the Secretary of State for a 75 day period of administrative review. After that point, the rule changes become effective.

The following rule change has been approved and will become effective on 05 July 2011:

Graduate courses used to satisfy the requirement to sit for the CPA Exam will no longer carry a 1.5 multiplication factor for course hours.

The following rule changes were approved by the Board in a Rulemaking Hearing on 06 May 2011. The anticipated effective date is in the spring of 2012. A summary of these rule



changes are as follows:

## Rule 0020-1-.01 Definitions

Delinquent License – added Expired License – added Member – revised to include additional firm entities

#### Rule 0020-1-.04 Fees

Penalty for late renewal of license changed from two \$50 fees added on January 31 and March 31 to one \$100 fee on January 31.

Fee for Reinstatement – Amount remains \$250 plus back fees; however, purpose of the fee is clarified.

#### Rule 0020-1-.08 Renewal of Licenses

Changes the late renewal penalty language to comply with fee changes noted above.

Reinforces the language that an expired license must be reinstated; additionally, the CPE used for license reinstatement cannot be used for license renewal.

#### Rule 0020-1-.13 Interstate Practice

Requires that any holder of a Tennessee CPA license who relocates to another jurisdiction and wishes to practice in Tennessee through the mobility statute must maintain their Tennessee license in good standing ("good standing" includes a "Closed" license).

#### **Rule 0020-2-.02 Education**

Increases the number of accounting hours needed to sit for the CPA Exam from 24 to 30 semester hours with at least 24 of those hours being upper division.

Rule 0020-5-.03/.04 Basic Requirements and Qualifying Programs (CPE) Decreases the CPE ethics requirement from four hours to two hours; however, both hours must be state specific.

Requires a Tennessee licensee living in and holding a license in another state to complete the 2 hour TNSBA requirement if the other state has no state specific ethics requirements. If the other state has specific ethic requirements, it may substitute for the TNSBA requirement.

Amends the provision of CPE credit for authors of articles and books to be awarded at the Board's discretion and only for those articles and books that are published.

## **Rule 0020-6-.04 Basic Requirements** (Peer Review)

Removes the requirement that each firm location must have a peer review. Adds the requirement that all firms must enroll in an approved peer review within 30 days of the date of the firm's licensure.

Other rule changes slated for an effective date in 2012 are simply "housekeeping" changes. They include:

- Removal of the reference to a written CPA Exam.
- Removal of all language contradictory to the Tennessee Mobility Law.
- Addition of a requirement to notify the Board of change in email address.

The Board of Accountancy does not take changes in its rules lightly. All proposed changes are thoroughly reviewed by the Board's Law and Rules Committee before reaching the entire Board for a vote. Keep an eye on our website for future rulemaking hearings – we are striving to stay current in an everchanging environment. This is YOUR profession and it is important that you express your views to the Board and to the Board staff!

## HAVE YOU RENEWED YOUR LICENSE?

# It's that time of year again...



Thanksgiving, Christmas, and for CPAs, License Renewal Season! Every personal license to practice public accountancy in the State of Tennessee is issued for a two-year period. In order to facilitate the processing of renewals, half of the licenses are renewed each December 31.

Odd-numbered licenses expire in oddnumbered years, and even-numbered licenses expire in even-numbered years. Seems fairly simple to remember, doesn't it? Those CPAs holding licenses with numbers ending in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 will renew this year.

Everyone due to renew this year should have already received a renewal postcard. Just follow the instructions on the postcard to complete your renewal online. Utilization of the online process results in your receipt of the renewed license much more quickly than using a paper renewal form!

When renewing online, please be sure to print out the receipt so that you can reconcile your credit card statement when it arrives. Each year during renewal season, the Board office receives numerous calls from licensees (or their spouses!) requesting an

explanation of the charges on the credit card!

Please be aware that the wording on the questions asked for renewal has been changed. Please read each question carefully and thoroughly before answering. If you submit an answer that is "incorrect," then you will receive a phone call or an email from the Board office requesting an explanation...so read carefully!

The renewal fee is still \$120.00. There is also a small service charge of \$4.44 when renewing online.

All firm permits expire every December 31, so be sure to get your firm permit renewal in as well! Remember that if your firm provides attest services the firm must be registered in a Board-approved peer review program before the renewal will be accepted. And just to ensure that everyone is on the same page, compilations ARE an attest function in Tennessee!

The renewal fee for firms remains at \$50.00.

A late fee of \$50.00 will be assessed on January 31 for all renewals that have not been received by that date. A

second late fee of an additional \$50.00 will be assessed on March 31 for all renewals that have not been received by that date. The late fees apply to both individual licenses and firm permits.

Practicing public accountancy in the State of Tennessee requires an active license. Practicing with a license that is delinquent or expired is grounds for disciplinary action. As of the date of publication, there are thirty-one (31) licenses that are delinquent but may be renewed on or before 31 December 2011 by payment of the renewal fee and late fees. A list of those delinquent licenses is available elsewhere in this newsletter. Remember, once 31 December 2011 comes and goes, those delinquent licenses become EXPIRED and the rules require that wall certificates for those licenses MUST be returned to the Board office!

Take the time right now to renew your license if you have not already done so. The Board staff will appreciate your timeliness, and you can rest easier at night knowing that your license is in good standing.

#### **CPA Exam Includes Use of Hand-Held Metal Detector Wands**

Beginning July 1, 2011 Prometric began using hand-held metal detector wands to scan all exam candidates at its testing centers in the U.S. Candidates are scanned prior to every entry into the testing room (including returns from breaks).

Examination candidates have been

alerted to this procedure via postings on the Prometric website and the PTC Test Center Regulations Form that is provided to candidates prior to checkin for the testing. The scan is accomplished in full view of the TCA DVR camera and will be recorded. The recorded information can then be used to assist in the investigation of

any complaints that might arise as a result of the process. Candidates refusing to be scanned will not be allowed to test. Exceptions to the process may be allowed if candidates express concerns relative to pregnancy, pacemakers or other medical equipment connected to or implanted in the body.

#### **NASBA** and AICPA Provide Licensees Mobility Information

CPAmobility.org has been created by NASBA and AICPA to assist CPA licensees in determining licensing/registering requirements (if any) when they perform services in states where they are not licensed.

By answering three basic questions the licensee can determine what needs to

be accomplished before working under mobility legislation. The questions are:

- **1.** Where is your principal place of business?
- **2.** Where are you going to perform services (target state)?
- **3.** What type of services will you perform?

Examples include, but are not limited to, a sole-proprietorship changing to an LLC, a sole-proprietorship becoming a partnership due to merging of two firms, or any changes in the ownership structure. If your firm makes such changes, please advise the TNSBA firm coordinator Patricia Turner at <a href="mailto:patricia.a.turner@tn.gov">patricia.a.turner@tn.gov</a> who will contact you regarding any further documentation required by the Board.
