Update from the Chairman of the Professional Land Surveyors Board

The Fundamentals of Surveying (FS) exam, also known as the Professional Land Surveyor-in-Training (PLSIT) exam, will convert to computer-based exams beginning in January 2014. Visit http://cbt.ncees.org/ for more information. Applications for these exams will be processed and presented for Board approval on a continuous basis. For 2014, the deadlines to have your FS applications in to the board for review are January 15, March 15, July 15 and September 15. After Board approval, all examinees will complete their exams at their local Pearson VUE testing center http://cbt.ncees.org/where-will-i-take-my-exam/ There are testing centers located in Nashville, Memphis, Knoxville, Chattanooga, Martin and Johnson City as well as throughout the U.S. and abroad. The Fundamentals of Surveying (FS) will be administered by Pearson VUE during four testing windows throughout the year: January–February, April–May, July–August, and October–November. Registration will be open year-round; however, you must apply to the Board first and be approved to take this exam.

The six-hour Principles of Surveying (PS) exam and the two-hour Tennessee Specifics of Surveying (TS) exam will continue to be paper-and-pencil exams in 2014; however, the PS exam transitioned from an open book exam to a closed book exam with a supplied reference book as of the spring 2013. Although the PS exam will remain in the traditional pencil-and-paper format for the next term, NCEES will eventually convert this exam to computer based testing. At the NCEES 2012 annual meeting, a motion was introduced and passed that NCEES would develop a CBT for the PS exam as soon as is feasible. A rulemaking hearing to promulgate changes to Chapter 0820-04 Rules of Professional Conduct and Chapter 0820-05 Continuing Education was held on October 24, 2013 at 9:00 am in Conference Room 1-B of the Davy Crockett Tower, Nashville, TN 37243. After review by the Attorney General's office, the rules will be sent to the Secretary of State's Publication Division. The rules become effective 90 days from the date of filing unless the agency files a stay or withdraws.
