Qualifications and requirements for DCS Volunteers:

- Must be 18 years or older
- TBI/FBI Fingerprint Check (DCS will pay for)
- Local Law Enforcement Criminal Records Check
- Child Welfare System Check
- Internet Records Clearance Checks
- Cultural Competency Training
