QUESTION #	QUESTION	STATE RESPONSE
1.	Are training courses already established for the DCS Five-Year Prevention Services Plan, Child and Family Service Plan, and Child and Family Service Review?  A. If so, will those be administered by the contractor?  B. If not, will the contractor be responsible for developing such training?	There is an established Five-Year Prevention Services Plan (FFPSA) Computer-Based Training.  The Division of Federal Programs will provide training for the Five-Year Prevention Services Plan, Child and Family Service Plan, and Child and Family Service Review.
2.	Will the engagement specialist role include any remote work?  A. If in-person, in which area of TN will the specialist be required to work?	The Engagement Specialists can work in the office of the grantee with an option to work some remotely and/or within a local DCS office. Many meetings will be virtual.
3.	Is there a Minimum/Maximum standard for the hourly pay rate for the engagement specialist?	There is not a set standard for pay rate. However, the maximum liability for each position was set using a \$20 per hour for 15 hour work week.
