

Tennessee Course Code Nomenclature Beginning in the 2020-21 School Year

Beginning in the 2020-21 school year, the state has added new course code nomenclature. The chart below provides a detailed description of how to read the new state course codes.

The first element in the code is the course type: general, special populations, CTE, or special courses. The next two digits represent the course content area: a number between 01 and 27 (there is a leading "0" for numbers 01–09). The fourth digit represents the grade level (e.g., 3 denotes a grade 3 course). The last two digits represent the order in which the course was entered in the system (e.g., 00 denotes the first course entered, A00 denotes the one hundredth course entered, B00 denotes the two hundredth course entered).

For example, the course code for English I is G01H09.

G: General

01: English Language and Literature

H: High School

09: Sequential number (indicates this was the tenth course entered into the catalog into the system)

The course code for Grade 3 Mathematics is G02300

G: General

02: Mathematics

3: Grade 3

00: Sequential number (indicates this was the first course entered into the catalog into the system)
