Please find attached the summary review of findings from the School Nutrition Program's 2018–19 fiscal year administrative review of Murfreesboro City's National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program. This review was conducted the week of April 8, 2019, with the exit date of April 12, 2019. The attached summary includes the identified findings and the corrective actions required.

District responses and supporting documentation of corrective actions are required for all findings, and findings must be corrected district wide. The School Nutrition Program director must provide the responses to the findings via the Tennessee: Meals, Accounting, and Claiming (TMAC) system in the "Compliance" section, as discussed with the lead reviewer. Technical assistance areas do not require responses; these suggestions are only to help the district improve the program. They are also available in the "Compliance" section in TMAC.

All corrective actions shall be documented and supported in the "Compliance" section in TMAC no later than May 17, 2019. During this timeframe, if you find errors or points of disagreement in our findings, please contact me, to discuss next steps. If there are no errors or points of disagreement, please be mindful that refusal or failure to comply with the required, corrective actions within the allotted timeframe may result in potential fiscal action.

Upon receipt of Murfreesboro City's documented corrective action, the Tennessee Department of Education will determine whether the documentation is complete and resolves the findings identified. Once the department approves the corrective actions, your district will receive a closure letter closing the review within 30 calendar days.

1400 - Food Safety	V-1400	The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Manual Dish and Utensil Washing, FE- SOP7 and FE-SOP7a, was not implemented. No water temperature's or sanitizer test strip readings were documented.	Retrain staff on proper dish and utensil washing procedures. Upload a copy of the agenda, training roster, and completed monitoring log for proof of compliance.



500 - Offer versus Serve	V-0500	Offer versus serve requirements were not met. No incomplete meals were observed, but the leftover food returned to the cafeteria after breakfast in the classroom was not reasonable compared to the meals served on the day of review. The leftovers were excessive and indicated that students were not receiving a complete reimbursable meal.	Retrain teachers and educational aides administering breakfast in the classroom on proper offer versus serve procedures, including recognizing a reimbursable meal and reconciliation procedures. Upload a copy of the training agenda and roster of attendees to demonstrate compliance.
