

# **IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT NUMBER 16-86**

## **Name of the school system:**

McMinn County Schools (MCS)

## **Description of the violation:**

MCS's failure to provide speech services as required by the IEP amounted to a procedural and substantive violation of federal and state special education laws and a denial of the student's entitlement to a free appropriate public education (FAPE).

MCS's failure to provide progress reports amounted to a procedural violation of federal and state special education laws.

## **Description of the law or regulation determined to have been violated:**

34 C.F.R. §300.323 (c) (2)	When IEPs must be in effect
34 C.F.R. §300.320 (a) (3) (ii)	Definition of individualized education program

## **Corrective measures ordered by the department:**

MCS must correct the violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

1. Schedule training regarding the aforementioned regulations, as mandated by the IDEA, to the appropriate staff of MCS within thirty (30) days of receipt of this notice.
2. Provide documentation, including an agenda and sign-in sheet, to the department within ten (10) days of completion of the training.
3. Schedule an IEP team meeting to make arrangements for compensatory service for missed speech therapy.

## **Final determination of the department:**

The department will monitor MCS for compliance with the correction action plan until the department is satisfied that it has been completed.
