

IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Name of the school system:

Maury County School System (MCSS)

Description of the violation:

Failure to fully implement child find regulations in relation to students suspected of having a specific learning disability in the area of written expression.

Description of the law or regulation determined to be violated:

34 CFR 300.111(a)(1)(i) "Child Find"

Corrective measures ordered by the department:

1. Develop a screening process for all students to identify those who may be evidencing deficits in the area of written expression.
2. Implement explicit, research-based interventions for students who demonstrate deficits in the area of written expression.
3. Deploy progress monitoring tools to be used to measure the progress of students receiving explicit, research-based intervention in the area of written expression.
4. Train all staff on said procedures and ensure fidelity of implementation consistent with the requirements of the RTI² Manual located at this link:
http://tn.gov/assets/entities/education/rti2/attachments/rti2_manual.pdf.
5. Provide the state with a letter of assurance and supportive documentation indicating that these requirements have been initiated or put in place by September 30, 2017.
