Textbook Adoption Schedule - Section A

The Background:

State law, T.C.A. § 49-6-2202(d), requires the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission to 'establish appropriate deadlines for the review of textbooks and instructional materials by advisory panels and for its own review of textbooks and instructional materials.' In accordance with this law, every year the Commission approves an annual Textbook Adoption Schedule.

At the Oct. 6, 2014 meeting, the State Textbook Commission approved the adoption schedule for the 2014-16 Textbook Cycle, Section A, for Advanced Manufacturing, Information Technology, Human Services, and Education and Training textbooks and instructional materials. Based upon feedback from educators and publishers, the schedule has been revised and is being submitted for approval by the Commission.
