



Notice and Public Comment Instructions for February 17 Meeting of the Tennessee Historical Commission

Public Comments NOT concerning the waiver petition on the agenda will take place during the regular meeting portion of the meeting.

- An interested entity, group, or individual that wishes to provide a written comment prior to the meeting may do so by emailing the comment to: Ask.THC@tn.gov
- To be considered by the Commission at this meeting, the comment must be received no later than 2:00 PM on February 14, 2023.
- An interested entity, group, or individual that wishes to orally comment at this meeting must make their request by emailing Ask.THC@tn.gov no later than 2:00 PM on February 14, 2023. The request to comment must include the name of the interested entity, group, or individual. **REQUESTERS MUST SPECIFY THAT THEY WISH TO COMMENT ON TOPICS OTHER THAN A WAIVER PETITION.** The name of those who have requested to comment will be called in the order that requests were received. When the requesters name is called, the requester may come to the podium and the requester will have up to three minutes to comment.

Public Comments concerning the waiver petition on the agenda will take place during the respective hearing. Instructions to participate in each are:

Metro Nashville Confederate Monument Waiver Petition

An interested entity, group, or individual wishing to provide a written comment on Metro Nashville's Confederate Monument petition for waiver may do so by emailing the comment to: Ask.THC@tn.gov. To be considered by the Commission at this initial hearing, the comment must be received no later than 2:00 PM on February 14, 2023.

An interested entity, group, or individual wishing to orally comment at this initial hearing on Metro Nashville's petition for waiver must make their request by emailing Ask.THC@tn.gov no later than 2:00 PM on February 14, 2023. The request to comment orally must include the name of the interested entity, group, or individual. **REQUESTERS MUST SPECIFY THAT THEY WISH TO COMMENT ON METRO NASHVILLE'S WAIVER PETITION FOR THE CONFEDERATE MONUMENT. Requesters MUST be present at the meeting.** If a requester is not present when their name is called, they will forfeit their opportunity to comment at this hearing on this petition for waiver. The name of those who have requested to comment will be called in the order that requests were received. When the requesters name is called, the requester will come to the podium and the requester will have up to three minutes to comment on this petition for waiver.
