## NOTICE OF MODIFICATION REQUEST TO HAZARDOUS WASTE CORRECTIVE ACTION PERMIT

Covoro Mining Solutions LLC (Covoro) is providing notice of the submittal of a Class 3 permit modification to the existing Hazardous Waste Corrective Action Permit (TNHW-182) in accordance with Tennessee Rule 0400-12-01-.07(9)(c)(5)(iii). The facility (EPA ID TND007024672) is located in Shelby County at 2571 Fite Road, Memphis, TN 38127.

The Class 3 modification was submitted on April 28, 2023, to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) in accordance with Tennessee Rule 0400-12-01-.07(9)(c)(5)(iii) to add a new solid waste management unit (SWMU 53) for HCN refining caustic leak area with a final remedy of implanting industrial restrictions to the area and modifying Table 5-1 and Figure 3 of the permit to address the HCN west trench.
