## NOTICE OF INDIVIDUAL PERMIT DECISIONS

## March 15, 2024

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This serves as notice of the division's decisions on Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit or §401 Water Quality Certification applications previously posted for public comment. Publication of this notice serves as commencement of the thirty-day period for appeal by third parties pursuant to TCA 69-3-105(i). NRS23.094 Applicant: Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT)

**Activity:** The Tennessee Department of Transportation proposes restoration of 8,193 feet

of unnamed tributaries to Big Muddy Creek (Haywood County) resulting in 9,686 feet of restored channel. Impacts to 0.40 acres of wetland will be offset through 1.6 acres of wetland creation. The project is anticipated to provide compensatory mitigation for stream impacts associated with Project Blue Oval.

gas line in Knox and Sevier Counties with temporary impacts to 20 streams for gas line crossings by open trench, two streams by horizontal directional drilling, nine streams for equipment bridges, 0.044 acres of wetland by trench crossing, 0.025 acres of wetland for equipment bridge crossing, and one pond crossing via

open trench. Temporary impacts will be returned to existing conditions.
