and Stewart County.

The Tennessee Department of Transportation proposes permanent and temporary impacts to six streams, five wetlands, and a pond for roadway construction to Project Blue Oval (Fayette, Haywood, and Tipton Counties). Stream loss of 151 functional feet will be offset through the Big Muddy Permittee Restoration Site. Wetland impacts of 0.185 acres will be offset by purchasing credits from the Loosahatchie Wetland Mitigation Bank and the Hatchie Wetland Mitigation Bank. Temporary impacts to 0.144 acres of wetland will be restored and monitored for two years.

The work is for residential development. Purchase of 1.27 credits from the Madison County Mitigation Bank. Temporary impacts to 1.130 acres of wetland will be returned to pre-existing conditions and

monitored for three years.
