2018 Lobbyist Registration Audit of Tyson Grinstead

FINDING(S)

1. Tyson Grinstead failed to timely register for his employer (See Registrations section).

EMPLOYER(S)

• Sunrun, Inc.

REGISTRATION(S)

Tyson Grinstead registered as a lobbyist for an employer during 2018. Based on the audit documentation, Mr. Grinstead was an in-house lobbyist for his employer and registered both in 2017 and 2018. Based on his registration in the prior year, he appears to have a continuing lobbying relationship for the 2018 registration year. Therefore, he was required to register within seven days of the commencement of the registration year, January 8, 2018. Mr. Grinstead registered on January 27, 2018, 19 days late. Based on review of the Bureau of Ethics and Campaign Finance's lobbyist records, Mr. Grinstead paid all registration fees

LOBBYING AGREEMENT(S)

Based on a review of the audit documentation provided by Tyson Grinstead, he was a direct employee of the employer. The employer had no employment contract with the lobbyist employee. However, per statements of the lobbyist and review of his employment offer, it appears the terms of employment were within the statutes for lobbying activities including having no terms for contingency payments based on lobbying success.

FAMILY OR BUSINESS ARRANGEMENTS WITH PUBLIC OFFICIALS

Tyson Grinstead reported he had no business or familial relationships with persons who were officials in the legislative branch or officials in the executive branch.

TRAINING

Based on review of the Bureau of Ethics and Campaign Finance's lobbyist records, Tyson Grinstead completed his required lobbyist training for the 2018 registration year and paid all training fees.
