THE TRUTH IS IN THE NUMBERS...



In Tennessee, 43% of individuals released from custody for felony sentences were re-arrested within 3 years.



1 out of every 10 children in Tennessee has a parent incarcerated.



850 individuals are released every month from TDOC custody.

Men of Valor saves taxpayers
\$ 1.2 MILLION

for every 7 men who stay out of prison for 5 years.



For men who complete Men of Valor's year-long aftercare and reentry program, the recidivism rate is below 15%.
