2010 Lobbyist Registration Audit of Anthony Daniels

FINDINGS

Mr. Anthony Daniels failed to timely register as a lobbyist for four employers (See Registrations section).

EMPLOYER

- Lifeguard Ambulance Service
- French-Riviera Health Spa
- Dickson Electric System¹

- Greater Dickson Gas Authority¹
- Water Authority of Dickson County¹
- ¹These organizations were not required to register as an employer's of a lobbyist under T.C.A. § 3-6-301(16)

REGISTRATIONS

Mr. Daniels registered as a lobbyist for five employers during 2010. Based on the audit documentation, Mr. Daniels failed to timely register for four of his employers. Mr. Daniels had annual lobbying agreements for four of these employers whom he registered in 2009 and had terms in the contract starting on January 1, 2010. For these employers, Mr. Daniels would be required to register by January 8, 2010. Mr. Daniels however, registered on the following dates for each employer that was late by the number of days listed;

- French-Riviera Health Spa on March 12, 2010, 63 days late.
- Dickson Electric System on January 12, 2010, 4 days late.
- Greater Dickson Gas Authority on January 12, 2010, 4 days late.
- Water Authority of Dickson County on January 12, 2010, 4 days late.

LOBBYING AGREEMENTS

Based on a review of the documentation provided by Mr. Daniels, he had a written contract with each client. The terms of each contract appear to be within the statutes for lobbying activities including having no terms for contingency payments based on lobbying success.

FAMILY OR BUSINESS ARRANGEMENTS WITH PUBLIC OFFICIALS

Mr. Daniels reported he had no business or familial relationships with persons who were officials in the legislative branch or officials in the executive branch.

TRAINING & FEES

Based on review of the Bureau of Ethics and Campaign Finance's lobbyist records, Mr. Daniels completed his required lobbyist training for the 2010 registration year and paid all registration fees.
