After receiving her bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Middle Tennessee State University, Hannah began her tenure with the Department of General Services (DGS) in 2012. She started her career in the Central Procurement Office, where she developed her skills in public procurement.



In 2015 she transitioned to the division of Commissioner's Support, where she helped develop and grow a new division, the Office of Administrative Services for DGS. This office focuses on supporting all divisions in DGS in the areas of procurement and department-level IT support. Through the years, this office has grown to include procurement support services to many small commissions and agencies across State government, as well as enterprise-wide support in ID Badging and Parking Services. In 2021, Hannah was named the Director of the Office of Administrative Services for DGS. And in 2023, she was promoted to the Executive Director of the Division of Administration for the DGS.

Hannah is a 2018 graduate of the Emerging Leaders Institute (ELI), a 2019 graduate of the Accelerated Leadership Institute (ALI), and a 2022 graduate of LEAD Tennessee.
