1. Call to Order

With a quorum present, Ms. Daughtry called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. Mrs. Daughtry welcomed Mr. James Burkard to the board. Thereafter, a roll call of all board members and administrative staff present was taken.

2. Minutes

Ms. Susan Brantley made a motion to amend the minutes of the February 26, 2016 meeting. Thereafter, Ms. Carney made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sisley, to approve the minutes of the February 26, 2016 board meeting as amended. The motion carried.

3. Office of General Counsel Report

Jamie Formont, Assistant General Counsel, reminded members about the Conflict of Interest policy. She discussed that the purpose of the discussion is to ensure that the individual interests of board members do not conflict with or have the appearance of conflicts with their responsibilities to the Board. She presented the following report from the Office of General Counsel (OGC):

A. Litigation

There were no open cases in the Office of General Counsel to be presented.

B. Legislation

Ms. Formont reported that the legislature voted to extend the Board for an additional six (6) years until June 30, 2022.

C. Rules

There were no pending rules or regulations pertaining to the Board in the Office of General Counsel for presentation.

4. Investigative and Disciplinary Reports

Ms. Nichelle Dorroh, Disciplinary Coordinator in the Office of Investigations presented the report. Currently, there are two (7) open complaint cases in the Office of Investigations. There is one (1) practitioner currently being monitored following Board disciplinary action.

5. Financial Report

Ms. Vanessa Crutcher, Division Financial Officer, presented the board's financial report. At the close of fiscal year 2015, the Board had revenue of \$96,261 with expenditures of \$60,840. Added to the fiscal year 2014 carryover, the Board currently has a cumulative carryover of \$171,674. Ms. Crutcher advised the Board pursuant to the formula stated in the policy for health regulatory boards on fee reductions, the projected expenditures and revenue suggest the cumulative carryover is close to the threshold to begin discussion regarding fee reduction. Ms. Crutcher will present suggested fee reductions for the Board to consider at the next meeting.

6. Applicant Interviews

<u>Kendra Bridgewater, DN</u> – Ms. Bridgewater is seeking initial licensure as a Dietitian/Nutrition Examiner. The Board reviewed her file due to finding of two criminal convictions for Driving While Impaired (DWI) on her criminal background check. Ms. Bridgewater was not present but was interviewed by phone. After review and discussion, Mr. James Burkard made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sisley to approve Ms. Bridgewater for a license. The motion carried.

7. Administrative Report

Marcina Egedegbe, Interim Board Administrative Assistant, presented the administrative report. As of August 19, 2016, there are 1704 active dietitians/nutritionists licensees.

A. Heather Wanke

Mr. Sobowale presented the Agreed Citation on Heather Wanke, LDN #2102 for ratification. This respondent practiced on an expired license for twenty-six months (26) months and pursuant to the Board's lapsed license policy, an Agreed Citation was issued for this violation. Ms. Wanke agreed to pay assessed civil penalties in the amount of thirteen hundred (1300.00) dollars and the violation will be reported to health licensees' disciplinary database and also appear on the Health Department's website. Ms. Wanke's case was reported to the Office of General Counsel to review. Upon a motion by Ms. Brantley, and seconded by Ms. Carney, the board voted to ratify the Agreed Citation. The motion passed.

B. Callie Klein Weins, LDN, Respondent

Mr. Sobowale presented the Agreed Citation on Callie Klein Weins, LDN #2719 for ratification. This respondent practiced on an expired license for four months (4) months and pursuant to the Board's lapsed license policy, an Agreed Citation was issued for this violation. Ms. Weins agreed to pay assessed civil penalties in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and the violation will be reported to health licensees' disciplinary database and also appear on the Health Department's website. 9. Correspondence/ Other Discussion

Ms. Daughtry provided an update to the Board on the discussion with Representative Jeremy Faison, the chairman of the House Government Operations Committee, pertaining to an applicant with Certified Nutrition Specialist (CNS) credential who was trying to apply for a license in Tennessee but is currently prohibited from obtaining licensure in the State without meeting additional requirements contained in the Board's rules. Ms. Daughtry reported that the Board has not had any formal communication with CNS or the legislative representative pertaining to the matter. Attorney Formont advised the Board that correspondence to discuss progress is not necessary at this time. Ben Simpson, legislative liaison for Department of Health, informed the Board that further discussion regarding the matter will take place in December. Mr. Simpson informed the Board that three bills affecting the Dietetics/ Nutritionist Board were recently passed:

- A. The Dietetics/ Nutritionist Board has been extended for an additional 6 years until June 30, 2022.
- B. Public Chapter 763- Public Chapter 763 This act revises delinquent privilege tax provisions that would require the Department of Revenue to notify the licensee that failure to cure the delinquency or deficiency prior to their licensure renewal date can result in renewal abeyance. For purposes of the bill, "cure" means payment in full, entering into an agreed payment plan, or abatement of tax liability. Licensing boards will be provided monthly with list of licensees who are delinquent 90 days or more and boards may not process licensure renewal.
- C. Public Chapter 719- Allows licensing authorities for certain state regulatory agencies to consider whether a person's conviction for the commission of a felony bears directly on the person's fitness to practice competently when making determinations regarding the person's licensure status.

10. Board Introduction

Ms. Jill Talbert introduced herself to the Board as the new representative for the Tennessee Academy of Dietitians and Nutritionists (TAND). Ms. Daughtry, board chair, extended a welcome to Ms. Talbert on behalf of the Board.

10. Adjournment

With no further business to discuss, Ms. Carney moved to adjourn, seconded by Ms. Brantley. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 11:02 am.
