

Electrodiagnosis

It is the position of the Tennessee Board of Chiropractic Examiners that Chiropractic physicians may perform electrodiagnostic studies when properly trained and/or certified. Proper training would include a minimum of 150 hours in electrodiagnosis performance and interpretation.

The Board recognizes a person certified in electrodiagnosis by the International Academy of Chiropractic Neurology (IACN) and the American Chiropractic Neurology Board (ACNB), or an equivalent credentialing organization as determined by the Board, as qualified to perform electrodiagnostic examinations.
