
NOTICE: BOARD OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COUNSELORS STATEMENT REGARDING TENNESSEE CERTIFICATION BOARD (TCB) INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATION & RECIPROCITY (IC&RC) ALCOHOL & DRUG COUNSELOR (ADC) AND ADVANCED ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR (AADC) GRANDFATHERING PERIOD.

The Board of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Counselors realizes that Tennessee licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselors may wish to seek International Certification and Reciprocity (IC&RC) certification which includes the alcohol and drug counselor (ADC) and advanced alcohol and drug counselor (AADC) credentials. The Tennessee Certification Board (TCB) and IC&RC will hold a limited grandfathering period of six (6) months for any licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselor in Tennessee who is active and in good-standing to seek IC&RC certification. For this six (6) month grandfathering period, currently licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselors will not have to complete the IC&RC examination, but will have to pay a small application fee.

After the six (6) month grandfathering period ends, licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselors will be required to complete the normal IC&RC certification, including completion of the IC&RC exams.
