Understanding County Health Trends for Tennessee's 95 Counties

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## PURPOSE

Understanding County Health Trends is designed to provide a snap shot and quick reference of historical trends for ten health measures for all 95 Tennessee counties. Each county's report displays line charts that track health changes over time. Also displayed is a comparison of county changes to state-level changes.

The ten health-related measures displayed in this report were selected by county public health personnel as those that would be understood by the public as a snapshot of community health changes over time. National news about Tennessee's poor state health ranking may tend to discourage some and hide the actual progress being made by counties in several important areas. This report is intended to provide counties with historical data trends for the selected health measures in order to draw a more conclusive statement about their progress. Our hope is that this report will spark conversations and partnerships about how to successfully continue positive health improvements and develop plans to address negative health trends. Specifically, health leaders and community members may find the charts useful as part of a continuing community health assessment and community health improvement planning.

## STRUCTURE

All 95 of Tennessee's counties have an individual report displaying which health measures are improving, displayed in the green band, and which measure are not improving, displayed in the red band. In addition to the ten health measures, each county is provided with basic county information including: population, median household income, unemployment, over 65 and minority population. The county's last five years of overall county ranks from County Health Ranking and Roadmaps is listed at the bottom of each report.

## SOURCES OF DATA

The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute's County Health Ranking and Roadmaps provided trend data. Individual data sources vary across each health measure. The United Health Foundation's America's Health Rankings calculated Tennessee's overall rank for 2009-2013, as listed in Tennessee's report.
