Emergency Preparedness Assets



Tennessee Department of Health Emergency Preparedness inventory is strategically located across the State of Tennessee to ensure emergency supplies and equipment can be made available to public health staff and partners all over the state. **Agencies can request this equipment during emergencies by contacting the ESF-8 desk at TEMA at (615) 741-0001.**

Mobile Units

- **Mobile Operations Center (MOC)**: Three trailers are outfitted to be a Mobile Emergency Operations Centers with satellite-enabled phone, data, and wireless local area networks (LAN) and radio. Two of the MOCs operate as stand alone command posts, with the third MOC capable of providing satellite communications to nearby buildings.
- **Regional Medical Communications Center Bus (RMCC)**: Buses that have similar operational capabilities as a MOC but can be used to dispatch medical response assets.
- **Mobile Alternate Care Trailer**: Stores mobile hospital units, alongside hospital beds, IV stands, HVAC units, and generators. Four units contain 20 beds and one unit has 50 beds (total of 130 beds). The units can be joined together for large events.
- **AmbuBus**: Ambulance bus outfitted with stretchers (capacity for ~24 people) for mass medical transportation.
- **Decontamination Response Trailer**: Delivers tents and washing station equipment for mass decontamination.
- Support Trailers: Delivers traffic control devices along with emergency point of dispensing supplies.
- **Mobile Morgues**: Ten refrigerated trailers to provide mortuary. Each trailer can store ~20 remains.











Other Medical Supplies and Equipment

- Communications equipment (radios, phones, computers)
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Antibiotics

- Ventilators, respirators, and large coolers
- Mass casualty response kits (for triage)
- Deployable teams
