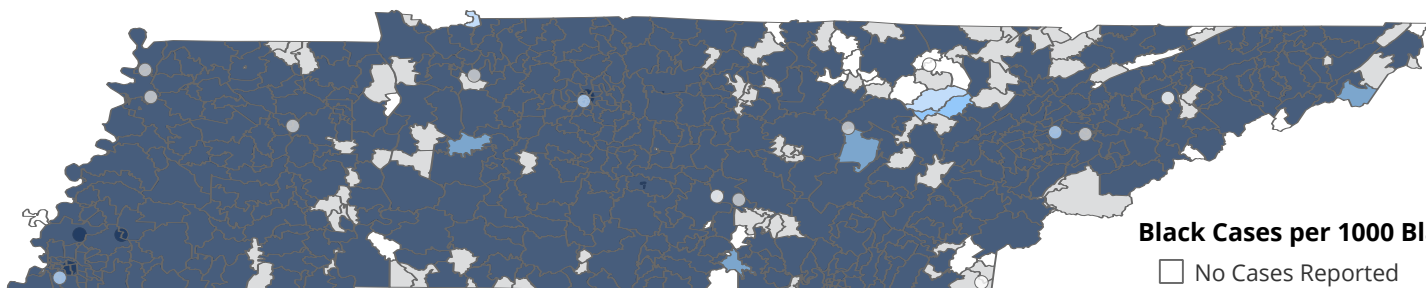

Rate of Black-AA Cases by Zipcode in TN

As of **5/4/2024** there are **2,735,641** COVID-19 cases in Tennessee, a rate of **40,058** cases per 100,000 Tennesseans. Additionally, **14.2%** (**388,549** cases) of the total COVID-19 cases are reported among Black-AA Tennesseans, a rate of **33,369** cases per 100,000 Black-AA Tennesseans. According to U.S. Census population estimates, **17.1%** of the TN population is Black-AA.



The map above displays the rate of Black-AA COVID-19 cases per 1000 Black-AA Tennesseans by zipcode. If a zipcode has a rate of 5.0 COVID-19 cases per 1000 Black-AA Tennesseans, it can be interpreted that 5 out of every 1000 Black-AA Tennesseans in the zipcode have been counted as a COVID-19 case.

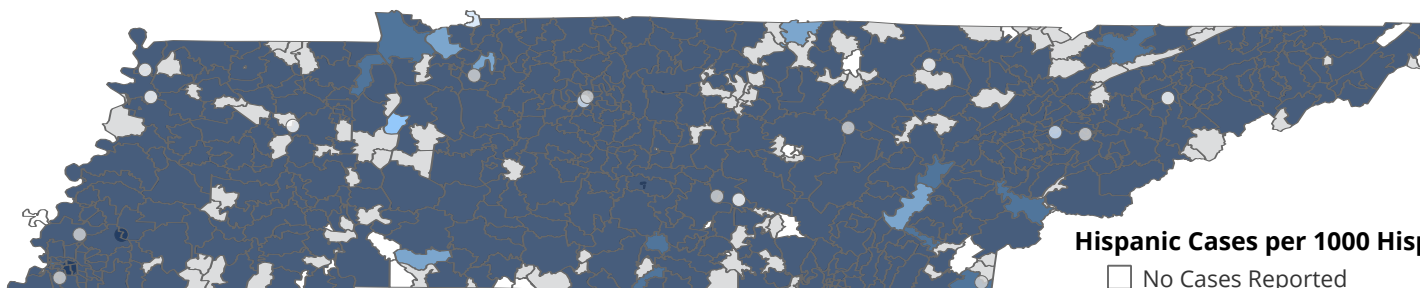

Additionally, **4.0%** (**109,292** cases) of the total COVID-19 cases are reported among Hispanic Tennesseans, a rate of **31,013** cases per 100,000 Hispanic Tennesseans. According to U.S. Census population estimates, **5.2%** of the TN population is Hispanic.

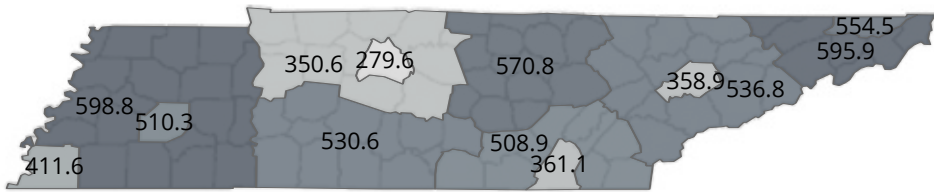

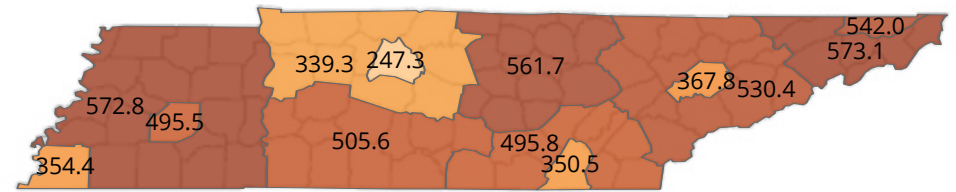

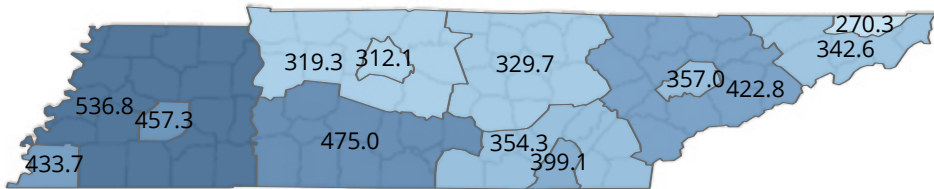
Mortality Rate Per 100,000 Tennesseans
 (# total deaths / total TN population) x 100,000



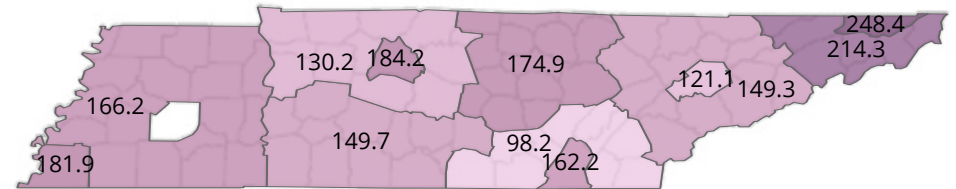
White Mortality Rate Per 100,000 White Tennesseans

 (# Hispanic deaths / Hispanic TN population) x 100,000

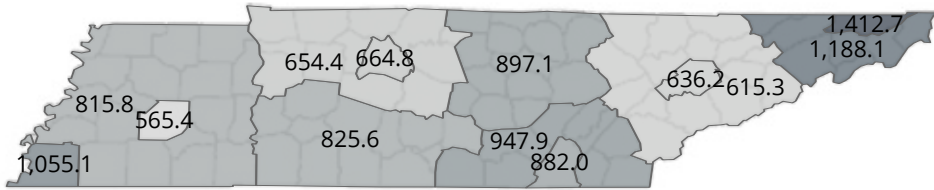

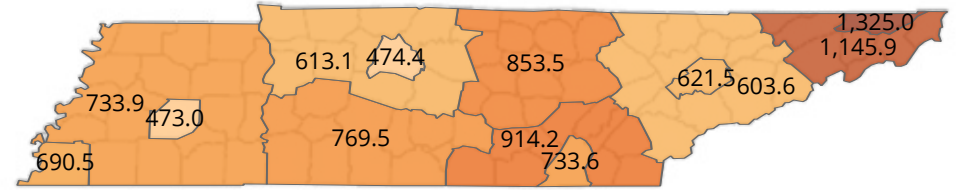
Hospitalization Rate Per 100,000 Tennesseans

(# total hospitalizations / total TN population) x 100,000



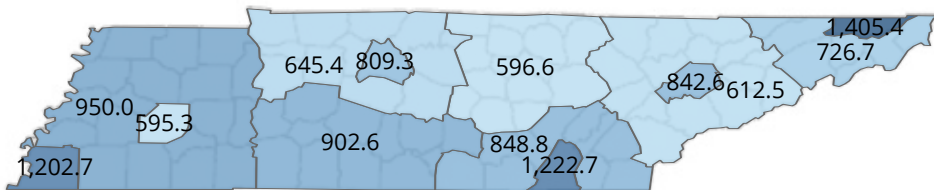
White Hospitalization Rate Per 100,000 White Tennesseans

(# white hospitalizations / white TN population) x 100,000



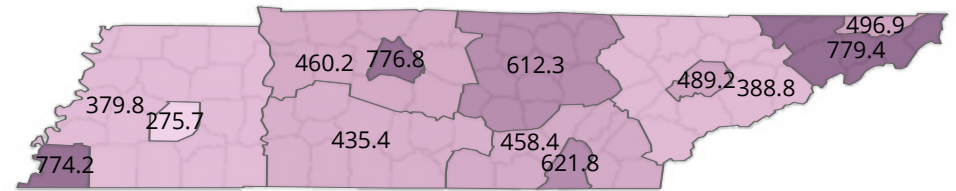
Black-AA Hosp. Rate Per 100,000 Black-AA Tennesseans
