Minutes

There were no minutes presented to be reviewed.

OGC Report

There is one (1) open case in OGC, which was scheduled to be heard as a contested case hearing today, but has been continued to a future meeting. There are no cases that have been appealed to the Chancery Court. There are no consent orders or agreed orders to be presented.

A proposed Senate Bill, Bill 0167, as introduced, would exempt Audiologists and Speech Pathologists from the current Professional Privilege tax, beginning January 1, 2016. This bill would amend TCA 67-4-17. Ms. Crosby-Davis made a motion, seconded by Ms. Flynn, to support the proposed Senate bill. The motion carried.

Ms. Lanford advised the Board that the rule change from the rulemaking hearing held by the Council for Hearing Instrument Specialists in June is still at the Attorney General's office awaiting approval.

Ms. Lanford also advised that she has language proposals for several rules, to be addressed later in the meeting.

Investigative Report

There are no open complaints against speech pathologists or audiologists.

Monitored Practitioners

Investigations are currently monitoring four (4) practitioners, and all files have been audited and are up to date.

Administrative Report

As of February 4, 2015, there are 383 licensed audiologists, 2400 licensed speech pathologists and 109 registered speech language pathology assistants. Between December 1, 2014 and February 4, 2015, 30 Audiologists have renewed their licenses. Out of those 30, 19 licensees renewed online. For the same time period, 174 Speech Pathologists have renewed their licenses. Out of those 174, 123 renewed online.
