Ms. Hunley called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. A roll call vote was conducted and a quorum was present. The meeting was turned over to Board Chair, Dr. Douglas.

A nomination at the previous board meeting was made for Dr. Mark Fleming in his absence as board chair. Dr. Douglas brought before the board the standing nomination and the call for a motion for Dr. Fleming as chair. Mr. Overstreet made a motion for Dr. Fleming to be chairman of the psychology board, seconded by Mr. Anderson. The motion carried. The meeting continued with Dr. Fleming acting as Board Chair.

The board welcomed Dr. Neelam Jain to the board.

Review/Approve Minutes

Upon review of the September 9, 2021 minutes, Mr. Overstreet made a motion to correct the administrative report to reflect the date December 2, 2021 and the wording in the ratified list to newly licensed behavior analyst, seconded by Dr. Douglas to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

Financial Fee Reduction Report

Matt McSpadden, Fiscal Manager for the division of Health Licensure and Regulation, presented the year end fiscal report. The actual revenue expenditures for the fiscal year 2021 came in with payroll expenditures of \$70,713, other direct board expenditures of \$42,542, total direct expenditures to the board of \$113,256, total allocated expenditures of \$74,317 and total expenditures to the board of \$187,573. The board fee revenue for the year was \$255,820 for a current year net of \$68,247. The total technology improvements were \$4,579. The cumulative carryover reserve balance was \$1,197,892.

Office of General Counsel

Ms. Turner, Office of General Counsel, stated that there are two consent orders, no agreed orders and there are seven open cases in OGC currently. She reminded the board of the conflict-of-interest policies.

LAWRENCE ELLEDGE has a lapsed license consent order. Dr. Douglas made a motion to ratify the consent order, seconded by Dr. Carter. Motion carried.

Administrative Report

Ms. Williams stated there are currently 1,486 licensed Psychologists, 293 licensed Psychological Examiners/Senior Psychological Examiners and 65 licensed Certified Psychological Assistants. There are currently 19 Psychologists applications in process, 21 newly licensed and 133 renewals. There were 8 retired, 5 expired, 2 reinstated retired licenses and 10 reinstated expired licenses. There are currently 0 Psychological Examiners/Senior Psychological Examiners applications in process and 40 renewals. There were 10 retired, 6 expired and 0 reinstated licenses. There are currently 3 Certified Psychological Assistant application in process, 2 newly licensed, 1 renewed and 1 expired license. The board members were reminded to sign their per diem and travel claims. The next scheduled Board Meeting is March 17, 2022. The additional dates scheduled for 2022 are June 9, September 8 and December 15.

Correspondence

Correspondence was sent in by the Association of Professional Behavior Analysts in support of the Tennessee Association of Behavior Analysts in seeking guidance concerning assessment testing like the Vineland and the SRS-2. They were requesting a decision by the psychology board back in 2019 be rescinded. Discussion ensued concerning the interpretation by the board made in 2019 as noted in the minutes that behavior analysts cannot do assessments. The board will consider this issue further at the next board meeting.

Dr. Fleming spoke about FARB (Federation Association of Regulatory Boards) and the forum meeting coming up in January. A motion was made by Dr. Overstreet for two board members and the director to attend the FARB 2022 January Forum in Texas, seconded by Dr. Douglas. The motion carried. The board was given the deadline date of December 7, 2021 to let the administrative staff know if they would like to attend.

Tennessee Psychological Association

Dr. Pamela Auble, TPA liaison, spoke about the potential legislation the TPA is going to introduce in the legislature concerning the result of the March 2021 Board of Examiners Meeting about the discussion of the temporary license statutes and rules. The concern is in regard to the license becoming invalid with the first failed attempt to pass the EPPP examination and the affects this would have on the clients being seen by the psychologist whose temporary license has become void and must discontinue practice with those clients. TPA would like to see changes made to the statutes and rules to reflect the allowance of taking the EPPP exam twice over a longer period of time and with an additional month after the second failing of the exam to provide for proper client care.

Tennessee Colleague Assistance Foundation

Dr. Brian Wind, TCAF Executive Director, presented his updated letter concerning the foundation. They have experienced a steady increase of inquiries and continue to feel some impact from the pandemic in the care of individuals. Two people are under active contract and one contract completed. They have four active administrative inquiries and one of those cases would be considered pre-advocacy collaboration.

PSYPACT Commissioner

Dr. Douglas made a motion that Dr. Mark Fleming be appointed as PSYPACT Commissioner for the board, seconded by Mr. Overstreet. The motion carried.

Dr. Fleming mentioned the apology letter put out by the American Psychological Association concerning racist practices in psychology and the responding letter from the Association of Black Psychologists. He highly recommended that both letters be read by the board.

With no other Board business to discuss Mr. Overstreet made a motion, seconded by Dr. Carter to adjourn at 11:49 a.m. A vote was taken and all were in favor. The motion carried.
