 SUBJECT: NFPA 72 – Door Locking Devices DATE: October 19, 2011 RULES: The following language should be used to

**ROLES:** The following language should be used to interpret the following law and rule: Allowable for licensed facilities to operate special door locking arrangements with generator supplied back-up power when there is a loss of power from the primary electrical power supply, so long as the fire alarm control unit is operational and powered consistent with NFPA provisions. Does not apply when special door locking arrangements are prohibited by code for that licensed facility types.
