POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING APPLICANT-SPOUSE OF AN ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY MEMBER

The Board for Professional Counselors, Marital and Family Therapists, and Clinical Pastoral Therapists ("The Board") adopts the following statement:

An applicant-spouse of an active duty military member may apply to the Board for an exception to board rules regarding contact and supervision hour requirements. Each case will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

Reason for Policy Statement: The Board wanted an applicant-spouse of an active duty military member to be able to request exceptions to Board rules to accommodate licensure.
