## Tennessee Board for Professional Counselors, Marital and Family Therapists, and Clinical Pastoral Therapists

## **Post Graduate Compensation**

Post-graduates working towards LPC/MHSP licensure may receive third party payments in accordance with 0450-01-.01 (11). This licensure rule requires the individual hold an LPC/MHSP temporary license if they wish to receive <u>direct</u> payment from an individual, organization or insurer.

For all registrants under this Board, payment arrangements with the practice setting should be directly coordinated between the Clinical Setting and the post-graduate. The board cannot advise on payment arrangements, including if the arrangement qualifies as a W-2 or 1099 agreement and recommends individuals consult a tax attorney for further guidance.
