Office of General Counsel

Administrative Report

Ms. Williams stated there are currently 318 active licensed Behavior Analysts and 6 active licensed Assistant Behavior Analyst and 27 provisionally licensed from the Department of Intellectual Disorders and Disabilities (DIDD.) Licensed since the last meeting which is August 11th through November 9th there are 78 new Behavior Analysts, 2 new Assistant Behavior Analysts and 2 new provisional (DIDD) licensees.
